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## BIBI GRAETZ TOSCANA TESTAMATTA 2023

Seductive aromas of flowers, cherries, lemon blossoms and roses. Medium-bodied, crunchy and polished, with firm, silky, ultra-fine tannins. It's all about structure with finesse. Such energy and tension. Complex and beautiful in the finish. A blend of sangiovese from Olmo and Lamole in Chianti Classico. Give this three or four years to come around.



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## BOSCARELLI VINO NOBILE DI MONTEPULCIANO COSTA GRANDE 2021

An austere wine, not without elegance. Restrained cherries, sweet violets and licorice plus a touch of rhubarb, radishes and orange peel on the nose. The attack is firm with ripe yet tight tannins, pleasingly chalky with tense acidity and a full body. Stern character in the finish allied to savory length and an overall graceful style. Best after 2025.



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CIACCI PICCOLOMINI D'ARAGONA  
BRUNELLO DI MONTALCINO  
PIANROSSO 2020

Intense, vibrant aromas of strawberries and raspberries, together with cola and flowery notes. Milk and mint nuances, too. Shows a lot of licorice elegance and blood-orange freshness on both the nose and palate with firm, velvety tannins and well-packed, brilliant acidity and a polished finish. Good aftertaste and amazing potential. Very classic. Drinkable now, but best from 2025.



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## TENUTA SAN GUIDO BOLGHERI- SASSICAIA SASSICAIA 2022

Plenty of red currant, cedar, iron and terra cotta aromas follow through to a medium to full body with graphite, sandalwood, red currants and fresh Mediterranean herbs such as thyme and rosemary. The tannins are chewy but polished in texture. This is a Sassicaia that needs three or four years of bottle age to come together and soften. A structured wine for the cellar. Try after 2029.
